

10 TIPS TO BETTER WEDDING PHOTOS



1. Have your shoes, flowers, rings, and dress out and ready when your photographer arrives.
2. Bridesmaids in their dresses before helping you into yours. Or in coordinating outfits.
3. Schedule your portrait time with good light if you want outside photos.
4. Select a space for getting ready that is not busy or dark. And keep the space tidy.
5. Check with your vendors on what they will wear. Simple monotone attire will help them to blend in better.
6. Request that your vendors refrain from advertising with signage, announcements and logo attire.
7. Ask your caterer not to serve while giving speeches. That way they are not disrupting the table.
8. Allow children to be photographed outside of the large group. They are more likely to be happy.
9. Schedule some private time for just you and your groom.
10. Move your head table away from a wall or background and into the room so that guests are your background.
